**Food distribution through Howard County Public Schools**

Participants are encouraged to bring a bag to carry home meals each day.

Meals will be provided at no cost to any HCPSS student, and all children 18 and under, throughout the 2020-2021 school year, subject to U.S. Department of Agriculture funding availability.

The food services program during the 2020-2021 first semester (Sept. 8, 2020-Jan. 28, 2021) consist of Grab-and-Go meals served [any day school is in session](#), Monday through Friday from 8–9 a.m. and 10:45 a.m.–12:45 p.m. Meals include breakfast, lunch, dinner and a snack, and may be picked up at either meal time. Beginning October 12, 2020, meals picked up on Fridays or pre-ordered for Thursday pickup also will include weekend meals.

Meals will be served at all [school locations](#), with the exception of Burleigh Manor Middle School and Hammond High School, where construction is ongoing. Meals may be picked up at any [location where meals are being served](#). Children do not need to be present; parents/guardians may pick up meals for their child(ren). Those with children attending multiple schools may do a single-stop meal pickup. Parents must indicate their child(ren)'s name(s) when picking up meals. Clients will need to contact their office, schedule an appointment, and fill out an application in person. They'll need to bring: photo ID, social security card for every house member, birth certificate for every child, and proof of Laurel residency. After they're approved, they'll be able to receive food once every thirty days. The primary client will receive two bags of food and one bag for every household member.
